- 1** Hear my prayer, O LORD; let my cry come to you!
- 2** Do not hide your face from me  
in the day of my distress!  
Incline your ear to me;  
answer me speedily in the day when I call!
- 3** For my days pass away like smoke,  
and my bones burn like a furnace.

- 4 My heart is struck down like grass and has withered;  
I forget to eat my bread.
- 5 Because of my loud groaning  
my bones cling to my flesh.
- 6 I am like a desert owl of the wilderness,  
like an owl of the waste places;
- 7 I lie awake;  
I am like a lonely sparrow on the housetop.
- 8 All the day my enemies taunt me;  
those who deride me use my name for a curse.
- 9 For I eat ashes like bread  
and mingle tears with my drink,
